
Verbal Problem

NOTES FROM OUR DIRECTOR

Randy Burton

I've done just about everything in OotM over the last 40 years, including co-regional director in Central Region, so stepping into the RD role for Eastern was a very simple decision for me. OotM has been such a huge part of my life, and my family's life.

Our biggest challenges are continuing to navigate the ever changing pandemic situation, rebuilding the membership base that stopped participating over the last 18 months due to the pandemic, and continuing to evolve how we engage teams and coaches.

A few years ago, we had no social media presence. We had never conducted a board meeting via online conferencing. I can remember when clarifications were submitted and responded via US Mail. Officials had to talk with international teams through translators (and there never was a translator available when you really needed one.) Online events and tournaments simply weren't even contemplated.

Now, we are pushing more and more information to social media, and all our board meetings are virtual. Clarifications are submitted and responded to via email, registrations are all online (and we now have a small committee of people who review responses before they are sent to teams, and all Problem Captains everywhere see all the clarifications.). We pivoted on a dime from in person to virtual tournaments. We now can communicate with international teams using tools like Google Translate.

This year is going to be really challenging as we plan for returning to in person events with the option to pivot back to virtual events as we monitor the pandemic situation. I've talked to some coaches and coordinators who aren't ready to return to in person events. I've talked with others who are very excited about returning to in person events. Of course no one knows what the situation is going to be in a few months so we just have to spontaneously adapt. Meeting the needs of all these teams and coaches is going to be really challenging.

Eastern Region is blessed with having the strongest volunteer base that any organization could even dream of having. The number of board members and their incredible dedication and spirit makes transitioning into the RD role very easy for me. The coaches and coordinators in our region have that same spirit.

I couldn't be more excited about the future of OotM and our region.


