**SKILLS FAIR REGISTRATION IS OPEN!**

Our annual Skills Fair will be held on Saturday, December 1, from 9:00 a.m. until 12:30 p.m. at Chesterbrook Academy in Cary. This event is intended primarily for Division I and Division II teams.

Space is limited and usually fills up quickly, so do not delay! The [registration link](#) is online on the Eastern Region website. Registration is by team and a **maximum of three team members may attend**. Your coach does not need to attend but students do need to be supervised by a parent or other designated chaperone. When you register, you will need the following information:

- (1) Your OotM membership name and membership number;
- (2) The name, e-mail address and cell phone number of one adult who will be attending with the team member(s);
- (3) E-mail addresses for any other adults who will be attending and/or coaches who would like to receive e-mails about the upcoming Skills Fair (*this is optional*);
- (4) The number of, and name(s) of, the attending team member(s); and
- (5) For each team member, his or her ranking of preferred sessions (you can see the list of available sessions by clicking on the registration link).
- (6) A credit card to pay the registration fee. The cost is \$10 per team member. There is no cost for supervising adults.

Registration must be completed, including payment, online and in advance. There is no on-site registration. **Team members who show up on December 1 without prior registration will have to be turned away because of space and material limitations**. Registered students will receive their assigned class list by e-mail prior to the day of the Skills Fair so they can go directly to their first session when they arrive.

Every year, there are more interested team members than spaces available. We can open up more spots if we have more presenters!
